Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of FIR No.31 dated 06.03.2019 registered under Sections 363, 366 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar on the basis of compromise deed dated 12.09.2019 (Annexure P-3).

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. This was the position on the previous date of hearing i.e. 03.03.2020.

Despite order dated 05.11.2019, whereby, direction was issued to the parties to appear before the Trial Court/Area Magistrate to get their statements recorded in support of the compromise, the parties have not appeared as per the report received from the Trial Court.

It seems that the parties are not interested in pursuing the petition.
