Status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Sardulgarh, District Mansa filed by learned State counsel is taken on record.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the learned trial Court and trial Court may be directed to decide his regular bail application expeditiously.

On being asked reason to surrender before trial Court, he submits that police authorities are inimical to petitioner and he apprehends that he may be implicated in other cases.

Without commenting on merits, the petitioner is at liberty to surrender before trial Court within 10 days and on his doing so, the trial Court shall decide his regular bail application within three days.
