Prayer in this 2nd petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.38 dated 23.04.2022 under Sections 323, 324, 451, 148, 149, 427, 506, 120-B IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar Rural; earlier one was dismissed as withdrawn on 04.07.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that new ground for filing this second petition is that one co-accused of the petitioner, namely Baljinder @ Amit has been granted the concession of regular bail by the Court of Sessions. However, considering the allegations in the FIR and finding that

this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, learned counsel submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and prays that a direction be issued to the trial Court to dispose of regular bail application of the petitioner expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court and moves an application for regular bail within a period of 07 days from today, the trial Court will decide the same within 03 days thereafter.
