Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.244 dated 28.12.2020, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sector 34, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the U.T., Chandigarh has pointed out that the present petition is stated to be the first petition for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner, but the petitioner has earlier also filed a petition bearing CRM-M-11283-2022 for the grant of regular bail, which was dismissed as withdrawn on 28.09.2022 and the said fact has

not been mentioned in the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the above, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after making a note of the said fact and also annexing all the zimni orders.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
