The petitioner herein is the plaintiff. He has filed a suit in the year 2014 for possession by way of specific performance of the agreement to sell. The plaintiff has been called upon to lead evidence. Assailing the correctness of said order, the present revision petition has been filed. It has been submitted that CR-94 and 4096 of 2016 are pending against the interlocutory orders.

Admittedly, the petitioner filed CR-2077 of 2014, which was withdrawn on 15.09.2022.

This Court does not see any reason as to why the plaintiff does not want to lead his evidence in order to expedite the disposal of the suit.

Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.
