The petitioner has filed the instant petition before this Court with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 to 4 to safeguard the life and liberty of the petitioner, who is being threatened by Respondents No.5 and 6.

The State of Punjab has filed a reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police-Dakha, Ludhiana (Rural) on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and submits that the petitioner had made a statement to SHO Police Station-Dhaka, District Ludhiana against respondents No.5 and 6, on which the parties were called in the police station. On reaching the police station respondent No.6 tried to manhandle the petitioner and DDR No.29 dated 02.10.2022, under Sections 107/151 of Cr.P.C at Police Station-Dakha,

Ludhiana, Rural was recorded and the respondent No.6 was apprehended and was produced before the Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Ludhiana-West. Apart from that, on the application moved by respondent No.6 to SSP Ludhiana (Rural), one FIR No.225, dated 22.11.2022 under Sections 188, 294, 504, 506 of IPC at Police Station Dakha, Ludhiana, Rural, has already been registered against the petitioner, which is stated to be under investigation.

Learned State counsel submits that the police is taking appropriate action as per law and the investigation is being conducted impartially. Learned counsel has further assured the Court, on instructions from SI Jaswinder Singh that the life and liberty of the petitioner shall be protected and appropriate action shall be taken in matter in accordance with law.

In view of the above observations, no further orders are required.

The petition stands disposed of.
