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**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)**

Through instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Code, 1973, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.65 dated 24.03.2022 registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) under Sections 336, 427, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25, 54 and 59 of Arms Act.

There is allegation against the petitioner and other accused that they came on motor cycle and fired two gun shots at the daughter of the complainant. They also fired four more gun shots in the air. Two more FIRs under different Sections of IPC including Section 307 and 325 of IPC are pending against the petitioner. The petitioner in FIR No.31 dated 31.03.2022 has been granted concessions of bail vide order dated 11.11.2022 passed by this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that no specific role has been attributed to the petitioner. There is no injury to anyone including daughter of the complainant.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Lakha Singh would submit that the petitioner is involved in two more cases, one is under NDPS Act and another is of 307 IPC.

There are allegations of commission of offence punishable under Sections 336, 427, 148, 149 IPC as well Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 and the petitioner is involved in two more cases which are serious in nature. No case is made out to grant anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
