“Counsel for the appellant has made a statement which is taken on record, stating that towards full and final settlement of all claims raised by the appellant, an amount of Rs.2,10,000/- be paid to him.

To us, this offer seems to be just, reasonable and equitable in the facts and circumstances of the case. Learned counsel for the respondent-Insurance Company prays for time to get concurrence from the concerned authority.

To come up on 28.09.2022.

Copy of the order be supplied to the representative/counsel of the respondent-Insurance Company.”

Mr. H.S. Oberoi, Advocate for the appellant was present. He signed the consent agreement, showing willingness to accept an amount of Rs.2,10,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs and Ten Thousand Only) towards full and final settlement of the claim in the present appeal.

Mr. Rajbir Singh, Advocate for the respondent No.3-Insurance Company has also signed the said statement today accepting the proposal made by the appellant.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.2,10,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs and Ten Thousand only) favouring appellant-Manjeet Singh S/o Sh. Manmohan Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 18.11.2022. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
