The instant petition has been preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950, seeking issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent No.2 to allow the petitioners to participate in the 72nd Senior National Basketball Championship for Men & Women and further for issuance of a writ in the nature of prohibition for restraining respondent No.4 from sending any other player except the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are the only players from the State of Haryana who have qualified the First Phase of the above mentioned Championship for North Region held at Nurpur, Kangra from 13th to 16th, September 2022.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that at this juncture, the petitioners would be satisfied in a case a direction is

issued to the concerned authorities to decide the representation dated 19.11.2022 (Annexure P-4) sent by the petitioners, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Pankaj Mulwani, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 whereas Mr. Ravinder Rishi, Advocate, enters appearance, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2-Basketball Federation of India. They have no objection to the aforesaid prayer of the petitioners being accepted.

Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and the respondent No.2-Basketball Federation of India, is directed to take note of the representation dated 19.11.2022 (Annexure P-4) sent by the petitioners and to pass a speaking and reasoned order thereupon in accordance with law after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties and preferably within a period of One Week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
