Matter has been settled *inter se* the parties and the Insurance Company is ready to pay a sum of Rs.7,70,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs and Seventy Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Accordingly, we dispose of the present appeal in terms of the settlement.

The demand draft of the abovesaid amount be brought before the Registrar of the Lok Adalat, so that the counsel for the claimants can collect the same. The Insurance Company has the option to transfer the amounts by way of RTGS, on details being furnished by counsel for the claimants. Compliance of this order be made within four weeks, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on the above said amount till payment from the date of this order.

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The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent–Insurance Company. The appellant (s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
