DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to decide the representation/complaint dated 17.06.2022 (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioners.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has submitted a detailed complaint/representation to respondent No. 3-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, regarding criminal conspiracy hatched by the private respondents, i.e. Respondent Nos. 4 to 6, against the petitioner, and the same has not been decided till date. It is further contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that he would be satisfied if the said representation/complaint is decided.

Notice of motion restricted to respondent Nos. 1 to 3, only at this stage.

Mr. Gurdarshan Singh Sidhu, AAG Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and states that he has no objection if the prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner is accepted.

In view of the above and with the consent of both the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to decide the representation/complaint of the petitioner dated

17.06.2022 (Annexure P-6) in accordance with law after taking into consideration all the relevant aspects of it, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Present petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
