Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.51 dated 22.06.2010 registered under Sections 353, 506, 186, 34 IPC, at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar as well as all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, including the order dated 03.05.2017, vide which the application filed by the petitioner was dismissed.

Though initially while issuing notice of motion, the trial Court was directed to adjourn the case beyond the date fixed before this Court, however, on 24.07.2019, main petition was dismissed for non-prosecution, as the petitioner failed to effect service upon respondent No.2 and there was no representation on his behalf. Thereafter, an application was moved for

restoration of the main petition, which was allowed on 03.12.2019.

Learned State counsel has, however, submitted that in the meantime, all the prosecution witnesses have already been examined.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this petition may be disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the pleas/defences at the time of final arguments.

Disposed of, accordingly.
