This is fifth petition seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 158 dated 4.10.2020 under Section 22-C of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Guhla, District Kaithal.

One of the ground for seeking bail is the custody period and the fact that the trial is not progressing at a decent pace.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gurmeet Singh, AAG Haryana, appearing on advance notice has produced order dated 14.11.2022 in order to show that the prosecution evidence has concluded and the statement of accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C. was recorded.

Considering the stage of trial, no interference is called for.

The petitioner would be at liberty to make a request before the Court concerned for expeditious disposal of the trial.
