The petitioner has filed the instant petition before this Court with a prayer to direct the official respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members as they apprehend eminent threat at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondents No.4 to 6 are trying to pressurize the petitioner and his family members to withdraw the criminal complaints submitted by them to the police for taking action against them. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 11.11.2022 (Annexure P-1) to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar for the redressal of his grievances and he shall be satisfied, in case appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 11.11.2022 (Annexure P-1) and to take action as per law.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3, at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vipin Pal Yadav, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Keeping in view the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without examining the merits of the case, respondent No.2-the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, is directed to look into the matter and to take an appropriate decision on the representation dated 11.11.2022 (Annexure P-1) as expeditiously, as per law.
