The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No.3 to 5, their agents, assignees, representatives, authorized persons to issue temporary number, Form No.21 and Form No.22 of open truck make TATA LPT 4225 BB-VI 10X2 belonging to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that after filing of the present petition, the temporary registration number has been issued. He contends that that petitioner has, however, suffered loss on account of the inexplicable delay on the part of the respondents in issuing the temporary registration number. He thus, submits that he is entitled to claim compensation from the respondents.

Taking into consideration the fact that the computation of compensation to be claimed from the respondents no.3 to 5 would be a disputed question of fact, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to the appropriate remedies available to him in accordance with law for indemnification/compensation to be so claimed.

Disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid.
