Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner is working on deputation with the Shaheed Sipahi Sandeep Singh Senior Secondary Smart School, Paras Ram Nagar Bathinda, Punjab since 2019 and the deputation to continue to serve with the State of Punjab has already been extended by the competent authority in the Education Department of Government of Haryana and as of now, there is already an approval with the petitioner to work on deputation with the Government of Punjab upto 31.05.2023 but the petitioner has not been paid either the salary on the ground that appropriate orders from the Government of Haryana are yet to be received.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that once respondent No.1 has passed an order, a copy of which has been appended with this

petition as Annexure P-8 extending the deputation period of the petitioner upto 31.05.2023, the said letter dated 19.07.2022 (Annexure P-8) is good enough to be taken into account by the Government of Punjab to allow the petitioner to continue on the post and to release the salary of the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that appropriate consideration on the prayer of the petitioner will be given and due orders required in the facts and circumstances of the present case will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order and in case, the petitioner is allowed to continue on deputation as approved vide letter dated 19.07.2022 (Annexure P-8), appropriate order will be passed and in case, any salary is yet to be paid to the petitioner, the same will also be released to her.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
