Instant petition had been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking transfer of investigation in FIR No.216 dated 03.09.2018 under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Civil lines, Patiala, District Patiala and file a status report therein.

Pursuant to the order dated 01.04.2022, the status report by way of affidavit of Deepak Pareek, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala has been filed detailing out the stage and status of the investigation being conducted into the matter. It has been apprised by the learned State Counsel that SIT has already been constituted to examine the matter and conclude the investigation in a time bound manner.
