[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/9 dated 06.03.2018 in CWP No.8979 of 2017.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/9 reveals that CWP No.8979 of 2017 was disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed and comprehensive representation raising all the pleas as raised in the writ petition before the appropriate authority with a direction that in the event of a representation being filed by the petitioner within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order, the same be decided in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within six months from the date of receipt of the representation keeping in view the principles of law enunciated by the Full Bench of this Court in CWP No.22252 of 2016 in case titled as Rajiv Manchanda and others vs. Haryana Urban Development Authority (HUDA) and another, decided on 22.11.2017.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order, Annexure R/1 dated 05.11.2018 which has been placed on record along with reply dated 06.03.2022, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order, Annexure R/1 dated 05.11.2018 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 with the liberty as prayed for.
