[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 06.09.2019 in CWP No.24660 of 2019 in case titled as Jatinder Kumar vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.24660 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the respondents to objectively consider representation dated 13.08.2019 and take a decision in accordance with the result of the DPC expeditiously, preferably within six weeks and to pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

[3] Petitioner who is present, contends that although representation dated 13.08.2019 has been decided and he has been promoted as Superintendent Grade-I, yet the same is not with effect from the date of entitlement, therefore, he does not press the same and may be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to challenge the action of the respondents in not promoting him as Superintendent Grade-I with

effect from the date of entitlement as claimed.

[4] The same is not opposed to by the learned AAG.

[5] In view of the position noted above the instantpetition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
