The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to ensure strict compliance of notification issued vide Circular No.RBI/2006-07/138 DNBS (PD) CC No.80/03.10.042/2005-06 dated 28.09.2006 (Annexure P-3) and further directing respondent Nos.5 and 6 not to take illegal and forcible possession of the vehicle No.PB13-AW-7871.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that during pendency of the present writ petition, the matter has been amicable resolved amongst the parties. He thus seeks withdrawal of the present petition.
