By this common order, three writ petitions, the details of which have been given in the heading, are being disposed of as all the petitions involve the same question of law on similar facts.

In the present petitions, the grievance of the petitioners is that they are working as Guest Teachers and are now being threatened with dislocation from their present place of posting on the ground that the Guest Teachers, who have been displaced so as to accommodate regular employees, are to be adjusted at their place, which is not at all envisaged in the transfer policy.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the displaced Guest Teachers are to be accommodated at the places, which are vacant and are not to be adjusted, where other Guest Teachers are already working.

Learned counsel for the petitioner in CWP 27239-2022 submits that the petitioner has already been relieved by the respondents vide order dated 25.11.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that though, the petitioner(s) have raised the said grievance before this Court by way of filing present writ petitions, but no such grievance has been raised before the authority concerned.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents very fairly submits that in case any grievance qua the transfer of the petitioners is raised by the

petitioner(s) by way of filing an appropriate representation before the authority concerned, the same will be considered and decided within a period of 04 weeks from the receipt of any such representation.

As the respondents have already undertaken to examine the grievance of the petitioners and the petitioners are yet to join their transferred place of posting, interest of justice will be served by allowing the petitioners to continue at their present place of posting till the decision on the representation to be filed by the petitioners will be taken by the respondent.

All the writ petitions stand disposed of in above terms.
