The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of appropriate directions to respondent No.3 to consider the representation dated 21.11.2018 vide which the petitioner has made the demand for his claim in the income which is coming from auction of Forest Grass and the 'Khair trees and the dead trees of the jungle.

The case has been called twice, however, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

It is evident that the matter is pending since December, 2019 and has been adjourned on repeated occasions at the request of the petitioner. There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner even on the last date despite the matter being called on twice. The position has remained the same today as well. Even the order dated 02.12.2019 has not been complied with despite lapse of merely 03 years.

The petitioner is seemingly not interested in pursuing the present case.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
