MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.547 dated 10.10.2019 under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt., District Ambala, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 13.11.2019, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation in this case is of misappropriation of funds of general public by Trinity Multi State Co-operative Credit Society Limited. Complainant himself was agent/manager of its Ambala Branch, while the petitioner had remained Incharge of Ambala Branch of the aforesaid society for only two months. The main allegations are against Sunil Srivastava, Managing Director, who alleged to have swindled the money of the society.

Notice of motion for 13.02.2020.

Petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within two weeks. In the event of his arrest being required, he shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, he shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under

Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which he shall loose the benefit of interim bail allowed to him.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by SI Sukhdev Singh states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 13.11.2019 is made absolute.
