The petitioners have filed the instant petition before this Court with a prayer to direct respondent No.2 not to harass the petitioners at the behest of respondents No.3 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that respondents No.3 and 4 have filed a complaint with the local police and respondents No.5 and 6 are repeatedly calling the petitioners to the Police Station and a threat has been extended to them to falsely involved in some criminal cases. He further submits that a detailed representation (Annexure P-5), dated 21.11.2022, has been submitted by the petitioners to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, and he shall be satisfied, in case an appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2 to examine the matter and to take appropriate action, as per law.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 and 2. at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vipin Pal Yadav, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, is directed to look into the matter and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the instant petition is disposed of.
