DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 for protecting life and liberty of the petitioner from respondent Nos. 5 and 6 and further seeking directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to register a case against respondent Nos. 5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner purchased an old Mahindra & Mahindra Motor Car, SUV REXTON RX 2, bearing registration No. PBI-0094 from respondent No. 6 through respondent No. 5 after paying entire consideration amount for the same to respondent No. 6. It is further contended that even after a lapse of two years original RC of the aforesaid vehicle has not been supplied to the petitioner. It is further contended that petitioner has submitted a detailed complaint/representation (Annexure P-3) to respondent No. 3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur in this regard but no action has been taken on it so far. At last learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if the said representation of the petitioner is decided in accordance with law.

Notice of motion restricted to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 only at this stage.

Mr. Gurdarshan Singh Sidhu, AAG Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 4 and states that he has no objection if the prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner is accepted.

In view of the above and with the consent of both the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur to decide the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-3) after taking into consideration all the relevant aspects of it, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Present petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
