The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 45 dated 17.02.2021, registered under Sections 406, 420, 506 and 34 of the IPC at Police Station Israna, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that it is a money dispute and a compromise has already been effected between the parties and complainant/victim Mohit has sworn an affidavit in this regard, which is attached as Annexure P-4 with this petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that two of the co-accused have already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, vide orders dated 12.08.2022 and 29.11.2022.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Himmat Singh, DAG, Haryana and Mr. R. K. Saini, Advocate, who are present in Court, accept notice on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant, respectively.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that there is a

valid compromise between the parties.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, considering the fact that it is a money dispute between the two individuals and no financial institution is involved and also in view of the fact that matter stands compromised between the parties, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is granted the concession of anticipatory bail, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
