Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.79 dated 20.10.2022, under Sections 452, 341, 323, 506, 427 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Kheri Nodh Singh District Fatehgarh Sahib.

The parties are present in Court along with their respective counsel and state that they have resolved the dispute *inter se* them in an amicable manner and are now residing together along with their 11 month old son.

Be that as it may without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, anticipatory bail petition filed by the petitioner is allowed subject to compliance of conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C

However, it is made clear that if the petitioner fails to join and cooperate with the investigation agency as and when required, the State would be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of the present anticipatory bail granted to him.
