The present petition has been instituted for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus/certiorari for seeking a direction to set aside the summoning order issued by respondent No.3 to direct the petitioner to appear before respondent No.4 qua the application given by respondent No.6.

Written statement on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 6 has been filed. Relevant extract of the same reads as under:-

“3. That it is humbly submitted that a detailed enquiry has been conducted into the aforesaid application fairly and impartially by the Enquiry Officer i.e. Superintendent of Police, Headquarters, Amritsar Rural from both the parties. On the basis of enquiry conducted, the allegations levelled in his application by the applicant/respondent No. 7, Gurnam Singh, were not proved as he could not produce any proof/evidence in support of the allegations levelled in his applications.

4. That it is humbly submitted that therefore the enquiry officer i.e. Superintendent of Police, (Headquarters), Amritsar-Rural vide his enquiry report dated 23.12.2019 submitted to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar-Rural recommended to consign the applications to record and the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural in consonance to the enquiry report, has submitted his forwarding report on 26.12.2019 to the Inspector General of Police, Border Range,

*Amritsar with the recommendation to consign the applications to record.
The reports are annexed herewith as Annexure R-1/T & R-2/T for the
kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court.”*

In view of the above, learned counsel appearing on behalf of
the petitioners does not press the instant petition.

Disposed of accordingly.
