This contempt proceeding has been initiated against the contemner for the reasons that when the contemner appeared in the Court of Sh. Parteet Singh Dhonchak, Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.)-cum-Judicial Magistrate, she made a video of Court proceedings and added a song to it and uploaded the same on TikTok.

On 03.02.2020, the following order was passed :-

“Respondent/Contemner is present in Court along with her counsel.

Learned Counsel for the respondent/Contemner prays for time to file an unconditional apology of the contemner along with the circumstances under which filming was done.

Learned Amicus Curiae has also submitted her written submissions. Same are taken on record.

In case the affidavit containing unconditional apology is filed in time, the personal exemption of the respondent/contemner is exempted till further orders.

List on 24.03.2020.”

Thereafter, contemner/respondent has filed an affidavit containing unconditional apology.

Consequently, we do not deem it appropriate to proceed further in the matter and the unconditional apology filed by the contemner/respondent is accepted.

Contempt petition stands disposed of. Rule discharged.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
