At the very outset, learned counsel for the revisionist-petitioner (defendant No.2 before the trial Court) submits that in fact, the petitioner is aggrieved by the pendency of the applications (Annexures P-26 and P-38) moved by him, along-with defendants No.1, 3 and 4, for seeking rejection of the plaint in the Civil Suit filed by respondents No.1 and 2-plaintiffs, as the trial Court is conducting further proceedings in the said Civil Suit without deciding the afore-said applications first and he seeks permission to withdraw the instant revision petition while praying that the trial Court may be directed to decide the above-mentioned applications within some specific time frame.

Resultantly, the revision petition in hand is hereby dismissed for having been withdrawn with a direction to the trial Court concerned to decide the afore-said applications, in accordance with law, upto 15.01.2023 positively.
