Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to grant the pay scale of Rs.10300-34800+4600 Grade Pay W.E.F. 01.06.2011 under the Assured Career Progression Scheme of 03.11.2006 (P-1) on completion of 4 years of regular service as Head Master along with all consequential benefits with interest @ 12% per annum.

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the representations (P-5 to P-7) are decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s) and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the aforesaid representations by passing reasoned order as per law within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
