The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for setting aside the order dated 23.08.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, whereby, the bail of the petitioner has been cancelled and bail bonds/surety bonds were forfeited to the State and petitioner has been summoned through non-bailable warrants for 14.11.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court on 23.08.2022 due to inadvertent and *bonafide* mistake as she was suffering from dengue fever.

In support of the afore-said contention, learned counsel for the petitioner has annexed the medical certificate dated Nil of the petitioner with the present petition wherein, it has been mentioned that the petitioner remained under treatment from 20.08.2022 to 27.08.2022.

However, the ground taken by the petitioner in the present

petition is not justifiable but to meet the ends of justice and in the light of the fact that no prejudice would be caused to the respondent-State, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court on 07.12.2022 and apply for regular bail.

In case, such an application for bail is moved by the petitioner before the trial Court, the same shall be considered on the same date and decided in accordance with law.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
