The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3(1)(d) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 for grant of parole to the petitioner on account of marriage of his daughter which is fixed for 9.12.2022.

While issuing notice of motion, this court had directed the State to file the verification report.

Learned State counsel has filed the verification report by way of affidavit of Sumit Panwar, Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Faridabad. It has been mentioned in the report that as per policy of the State petitioner falls in the category of 'hardcore convicted prisoner' and thus not entitled for grant of parole. However, it has been mentioned that the factum of marriage has been verified and the marriage of the daughter of petitioner is fixed for 9.12.2022 at Vishwakarma Marriage Garden, Anshal Sushant City Second, Manchwa, Jaipur with Rajesh son of Kanheya Lal.

Having perused the record, it is apparent that the marriage of the daughter of the petitioner is fixed for 9.12.2022. Though, as per the State policy petitioner falls in the category of 'hardcore convicted prisoner', however, petitioner is seeking parole to attend the marriage of his daughter. As per the verification report there is no one else in the family to make necessary arrangements of marriage. It has been mentioned that petitioner has two sons, however, they are living separately.

Keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, this court is of the opinion that the petitioner deserves to be granted parole for performing marriage of his daughter. Accordingly, petitioner is allowed parole w.e.f. 8.12.2022 to 14.12.2022 on his furnishing requisite bail bonds/Surety bonds and completing necessary formalities as required by the concerned authorities. Petitioner is directed to surrender before the jail authorities on 15.12.2022 at 11 A.M.

Petition stands allowed.
