Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C for grant of interim regular bail for a period of three weeks in case FIR No.86 dated 06.07.2021 registered under Sections 21, 25 and 29 Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Bhargo Camp, Jalandhar to enable her to participate in the wedding ceremony of her son scheduled for 11th December, 2022.

Learned counsel for petitioner contends that the marriage of the petitioner's son is to be solemnized on 11.12.2022 and has invited the attention of the Court to the marriage card (Annexure P-2). He prays that the petitioner be released on bail for a period of three weeks.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Kunal Muthreja, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and does not dispute the ground raised in the present petition, however, he has opposed the prayer on the ground that the petitioner was arrested along with the amount of Rs.3,45,000/-. He further

submits that the petitioner is involved in three more cases of similar nature. He submits that there is every possibility that the petitioner may abscond.

After considering the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and the stand of learned State counsel, this Court is not inclined to extend the concession of interim regular bail to the petitioner as she can attend this function in custody as well.

Resultantly, no case is made out for releasing the petitioner on interim regular bail, however, it is directed that the Superintendent Central Jail, Kapurthala, after verification shall facilitate the visit of the petitioner to the venue and after conclusion of the function, the petitioner be brought back to the prison. It is made clear that all the expenses for travel, etc. shall be borne by the petitioner.
