Learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 and 2 submits that the passport has been issued to the petitioner and as such, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Shamsheer Singh, submits that the passport was issued to the petitioner way-back on 09.06.2020 and affirms that in view of same, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

A perusal of the paper-book would reveal that prayer is for issuance of a writ of certiorari for quashing the communications dated 10.04.2018 (Annexure P-3) and 16.08.2018 (Annexure P-7) and consequently, a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 and 2 to reissue the passport.

In view of the statement made, as noticed above, the impugned communications dated 10.04.2018 (Annexure P-3) and 16.08.2018 (Annexure P-7), have not come in way for issuance of passport to the petitioner and as such, the relief claimed in the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
