The petitioner's suit for grant of decree of possession by way of specific performance of the agreement to sell is pending before the trial court and an application filed by the petitioner, for permission to amend the plaint, when the trial of the suit was at the final stage, has been dismissed. The petitioner wants to add the relief of joint possession qua the share of the defendants. Once the relief of possession has already been prayed for, the relief of joint possession is implicit therein.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere is made out. However, it is clarified that suit filed by the plaintiff shall not be dismissed on the ground that the prayer for suit for relief of joint possession has not been made.
