[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 12.07.2022, in CWP-14509-2022 in case titled as 'Baldev Singh versus State of Punjab and others'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP-14509-2022 was disposed of vide order dated 12.07.2022 by directing decision be taken on the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice 22.07.2020.

[3] At the outset, learned Asstt. AG, Punjab, has produced copy of order dated 08.12.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof, states that he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 08.12.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with
