The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to consider and promote the petitioner as Supervisor/Superintendent Grade-2/Superintendent Grade-1 w.e.f. 05.05.1981 when juniors has been promoted with all consequential benefits including arrears of pay etc and his case was left out for no fault on his part the action of the respondents not promoting the petitioner as Superintendent Grade-2/Superintendent Grade-1 w.e.f. Juniors has been promoted exemplifies the typical bureaucratic attitude and deserves severe condemnation.

Ms. Anju Sharma Kaushik, DAG, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

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Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the representation dated 06.06.2019 (Annexure P-10) moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the relief, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
