The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 praying for issuance of directions to the respondents not to entertain any suit or other proceedings against the Corporate Debtor in liquidation in view of specific bar contained under Section 33 (5) and Section 231 read with Section 60 (5) and Section 238 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016.

Learned counsel for the Liquidator has apprised that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous at this stage since the suits that were filed had been dismissed in default.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Needless to mention that in the event any application is moved by the plaintiffs for restoration of the civil suits, appropriate application may be moved in accordance with law under the provisions of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016.
