DEEPAK MANCHANDA J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to official respondent No. 2 to decide the representation dated 30.09.2022 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner against respondent Nos. 4 to 7 for cheating the petitioner with Rs. 3,90,000/- on the pretext of sending him abroad.

At the very outset, it is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that a detailed representation (Annexure P-5) has been sent to the respondent No. 2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, with regard to cheating committed by respondent Nos. 4 to 7, but no action has been taken on it so far and he would be satisfied if the said representation is decided.

Notice of motion restricted to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 only, at this stage.

Mr. Gurdardhan Singh Sidhu, AAG Punjab who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and submits that he has no objection if the prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner is accepted.

In view of the above and with consent of both the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to decide the representation of the petitioner within a period of

order, after taking into consideration all the relevant aspects of representation.

Present petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
