While assailing the concurrent findings of fact arrived at by the courts below, the plaintiff has filed the present appeal. His suit for grant of decree of permanent injunction in order to restrain the defendant from interfering in his peaceful possession has been dismissed by both the courts. Both the courts have found that the plaintiff is recorded to be a trespasser in the land, which is owned by the Central Government. Neither the Central Government has been impleaded as party in the suit nor the appellant has proved any right, title or interest in the property. Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.
