Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take action against the respondent No.4 by taking action on the representation dated 16.09.2019 (Annexure P-4).

In reply filed on behalf of respondent-State, para 3 of the preliminary submissions has been recorded as under:

“3. That the petitioner had filed an application dated 14.06.2019 before the office of the Deputy Commissioner, Gurdaspur (respondent No.2) and same was marked to the respondent No.3 (SSP/Gurdaspur) to listen to applicant personally. The said application was marked to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Economic Offences Wing, Gurdaspur to verify the matter and take necessary action as per law. During the inquiry, it was revealed that the petitioner recorded his statement before the Inquiry Officer that the case has been filed in the Court of Sh. Vishesh, Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur and he agree with decision of learned court. The case is pending in the learned court. It is also submitted that his son Kanwalpreet Singh (respondent No.5) had filed a petition in the Hon'ble High Court vide CRM-M-11283 of 2018, which is fixed for 21.01.2020. The Inquiry officer recommended that no action is required in case at this stage as matter is pending in the court for the judicial verdict and no further action on

this complaint is required. Hence, the complaint may be filed.”

In view of the aforesaid stand taken by the respondent-State, nothing remains to be adjudicated at the hands of this Court.

Consequently, the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
