Instant writ petition seeks a mandamus directing the respondents to amend the Bill of Entry No.2328657 dated 07.03.2019 under Section 149 of the Customs Act, 1962.

We find that as regards the prayer made in the instant petition, petitioner has already approached the Deputy Commissioner of Customs (Appraisal) Gate Rail Freight Limited, Ludhiana in terms of filing an application dated 17.01.2022 (Annexure P-4).

It is the contention raised by counsel that till date no response to such application has been received.

Since an advance copy of the petition already stood served upon the respondents, Ms. Niharika Gupta, learned Jr. Standing counsel has entered appearance on behalf of the respondents.

A very fair stand has been taken by counsel for the respondents that the application dated 17.01.2022 (Annexure P-4) already filed by the petitioner would be considered and a decision thereupon would be taken in

accordance with law and by passing a reasoned order within a period of four weeks from today.

Statement is accepted.

No further directions are required to be passed.

We may clarify that we have not examined the prayer/claim of the petitioner on merits.
