The petitioners have filed the instant petition before this Court with a prayer to direct respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners and also to direct respondents No. 2 and 3 not to allow respondents No. 4 to 6 to interfere with the lives and liberty of the petitioners.

During the course of proceedings, Mr. J.S. Kang, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents No. 4 to 6 and has filed his power of attorney on their behalf even prior to issuance of notice of motion.

Learned counsel, on instructions from respondents No. 4 to 6, who are present in the Court, submits that they will not threaten or interfere with the lives and liberty of both the petitioners. They have no objection to the marriage performed by the petitioners, as submitted in the present petition.

In view of statement made by learned counsel for respondents No. 4 to 6, no further directions are required and the petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
