**SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)**

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for directing official respondents No.1 to 3 to ensure that the petitioner may not be harassed by respondent No.4 at the instance of respondents No.5 to 7. Further prayer has been made that respondents No.1 to 3 may be directed to take legal action against respondents No.5 to 7 for harassing and threatening the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, who is 63 year old lady, has a dispute with respondents No.5 to 7, who are her daughter-in-law, son and husband, respectively. By referring to the pleadings, he submits that a number of cases are pending *inter se* parties and the petitioner is being maltreated by the private respondents. He submits that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 19.11.2022 to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, Annexure P-7, however no action has been taken thereon and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned respondent to look into the same.

Notice of motion confined to respondents Nos.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. P.S.Grewal, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No.1 to 3.

Having considered the prayer made by counsel for the petitioner, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar-respondent No.3, to examine the representation, Annexure P-7, and to take suitable action thereon as warranted in accordance with law.
