[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1 dated 30.09.2022 in CWP-22848-2022.

[2] A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that CWP-22848-2022 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide the representation filed by the petitioners in accordance with law within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned State counsel has filed compliance report by way of affidavit of the respondent. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal of order Annexure R-1/T dated 12.12.2022 states that in view of rejection of claim of the petitioners as contained in the representation filed by them, he does press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order Annexure R-1/T dated 12.12.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in

accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent(s) under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
