Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.64 dated 10.09.2019 registered under Sections 21 and 29 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Kacha Pakka, District Tarn Taran as vide order dated 23.11.2022, the bail granted to the petitioner has been cancelled by the trial Court.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was granted regular bail vide order dated 21.10.2019 and he was regularly attending the Court, however, he absented from the Court proceedings on 23.11.2022 and his bail/surety bonds were cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and apply for fresh bail.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Navneet Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has not disputed the factual position.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the aforesaid factual position, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today and he will be released on bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

This will, however, be subject to the condition that the petitioner will deposit the costs of Rs.3,000/- with the District Legal Services Authority, concerned.
