Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners, who were in the cadre of “Rest of Haryana” were transferred to Mewat Cadre by the respondents, which act on the part of the respondents is totally arbitrary and illegal and contrary to the rules governing the service.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the grievance which has been raised in the present petition, the petitioners have already approached the respondents by serving upon them a legal notice dated 11.11.2022 (Annexure P-5), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the legal notice of the petitioner dated 11.11.2022 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the legal notice dated 11.11.2022 (Annexure P-5), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 11.11.2022 (Annexure P-5) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
