The present second petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.111 dated 01.05.2022 under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 324, 452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadhaura, District Yamuna Nagar.

The earlier petition bearing CRM-M-26625-2022 had been dismissed after noticing the criminal antecedents of the petitioner and his involvement in as many as 10 other criminal cases including five cases having been registered for similar offences committed under Section 307 IPC. The petitioner has now filed the present petition stating that investigation in the case is complete and he is no longer required for further

investigation of the present case.

Be that as it may, once the anticipatory bail filed by the petitioner was dismissed earlier after noticing his criminal antecedents, the said fact remains the same.

Filing of the instant petition shows that despite dismissal of the bail petition earlier, the petitioner evaded the process of law. The present petition is accordingly dismissed with costs of ₹5,000/- to be deposited by the petitioner with the High Court Legal Services Committee within a period of one month from today.
