Grievance of the petitioners is that they are working on the post of Eduset Chowkidars in Government Schools of Haryana for the last more than 10 years but their services have not been regularised by the respondents so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioners places reliance upon *Secretary, State of Karnataka Versus Uma Devi and others 2006 (4) SCC 1* for the relief in question. Precisely for the claim in question, the petitioners have also served a legal notice dated 15.10.2022 upon the respondent which is still pending consideration before the authorities.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case their legal notice is directed to be decided by the respondent No.2 in a time bound manner by way of a speaking order.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Sumit Gupta, Addl.AG Haryana

accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

In view of the nature of the order which this Court proposes to be passed at this stage, there is no necessity of calling upon any response from the State.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition, however, with a direction to respondent No.2 to take note of pending legal notice dated 15.10.2022 and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
